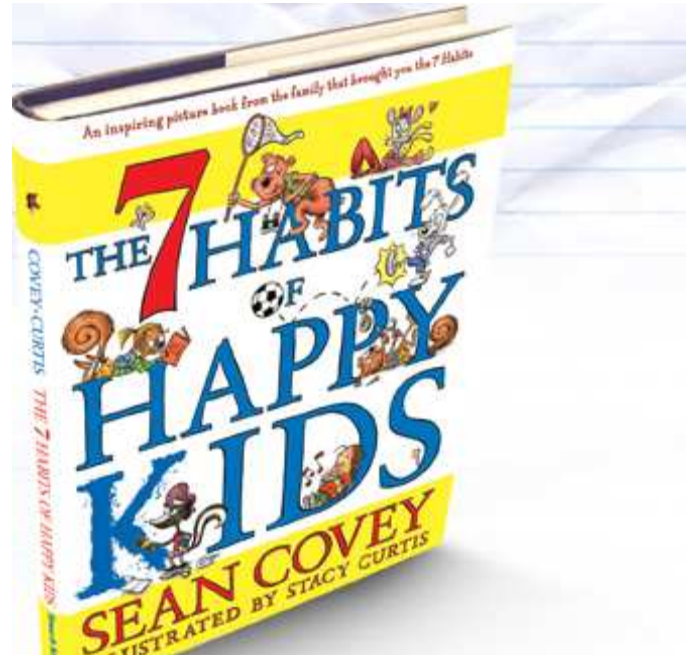
Vice Principal's News
