Science

Building with a Variety of Materials: Different structures and their utility, identifying shapes within structures, building structures to solve problems.

Testing Materials and Designs: Materials and their properties, grouping similar materials based on utility, how materials are manufactured, applying materials knowledge to theoretical builds/designs.

Social Studies

Countries around the world (food, traditions, languages, clothing, healthcare, etc.) Mouseguard role-playing game: Students are grouped by country. Students research their country, plan their town, write about its history in order to advance through the adventure storyline.

Phys. Ed

Basketball: Dribbling, passing, shooting, defending, movement skills, basketball games. Indigenous games: Bone game (countin/throwing), Tatanka Tatanka (tag), lacrosse, etc.

Realism: Self-portrait, drawing an invention/machine with identifiable parts, Leonardo Davinci & importance to Art/Science.
