Pre K – Mr. Massey

Kindergarten – Ms. Thomson

In kindergarten we continue to work on our numbers from 0-10. In literacy we have begun using Words their Way and are reviewing letters and beginning to blend simple CVC words. In science we are about to talk about the different ways that things move.

Grade One – Mrs. McEachren/Miss Warmington

Grade One has been busy. Students have been working hard on building their reading skills and making their reading sound like talking. Students have also been working on developing their independent writing skills by writing complete sentences that have capitalization and punctuation. Our main focus for the month has been kindness and students in 1Mc wrote about things close to their heart. We have also been working hard at becoming problem solvers when we are working in Guided Reading centres.

In Math, we have completed our unit on Geometry and have moved on to Addition and Subtraction. Students have learned about the operations of addition and subtraction, as well as some tools that they can use to help them solve addition and subtraction equations. Students are now working on developing some strategies that will make solving problems easier. We have continued to work in Guided Math centres.

In Science, students have been learning about Matter. They have learned that matter is all around us and that we can describe the properties of matter using our 5 senses and by measuring.

In Social Studies, we have finished learning about our Rights and Responsibilities and will move on to how we make decisions as a group.

Finally, we have started to learn about Penguins! Students are very excited to learn all they can about penguins in the hopes that they will get a visit from a real penguin to help showcase what they have learned.

Grade Two – Mrs. Roe/Ms. Tower

Grade 2s have been very busy with our Roots of Empathy program. We have learned about empathy, sleep, and safety as it relates to changes in newborns. We have enjoyed seeing the big changes that are happening for our babies who are now 9 months old. Our babies are beginning to explore the world around them and interact with us more during their visits. We made a special nursery rhyme book for our babies where we illustrated our favourite nursery rhyme. We are excited to share our stories and songs with our babies this week.

This month we decided to focus on and explore the concept of gratitude. Students read stories, brainstormed ideas, and wrote about reasons why they are grateful every day. Students shared that they were grateful for the earth, school, food, and family, among others.

We made woven paper valentines for the seniors at the Bon Accord Jewel Box.

In Social Studies, we are connecting our learning of the Northern community of Iqaluit with Science unit as we designed, built and redesigned an inuksuk. This helps us meet the outcomes for Social Studies where we learn about the North and Inuit traditions and culture, as well as our Computing Science unit in Science.

We have booked a Field Trip to Telus World of Science for May where we will be interacting with the Science display as well as watching an IMAX movie- Flight of the Monarch. This will tie in nicely with our Science unit as we are expecting our butterfly kits early in May.
